



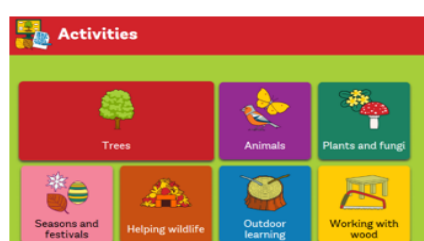
Hi Willow Class,

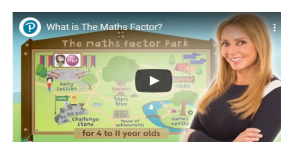
