Mrs Sanders has made a power point that explains what you are going to be doing, so check the school website for the link.

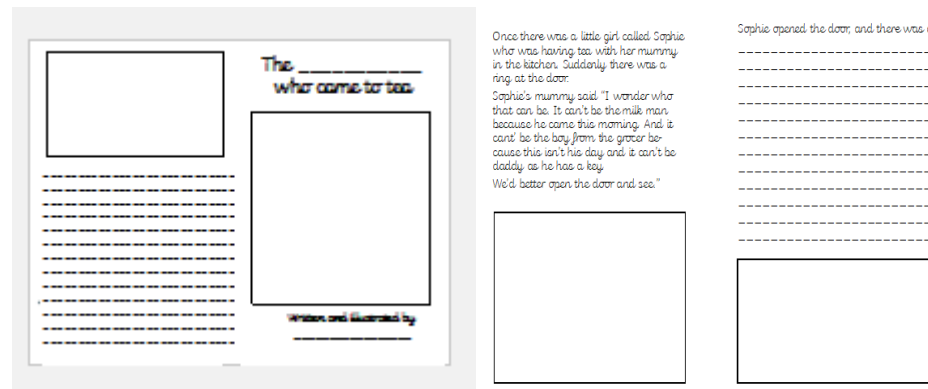
You might already have your own copy of the story but here is a video link where you can listen to the story.

Draw and label a different, new visitor for Sophie, then write your character into a new story for Sophie.

Use the scaffold to make your book. Fold the pages before you start and put the pages in the correct order.



Fill the front cover in with the name of your new character, then introduce them on the first page. The story has been started for you and you will need to decide how your story ends.

You could act out your story at home. You could pretend to be Sophie and have a tea party with the character you have created. You could make sandwiches and cakes.
